



ABOUT CARVER

At George Washington Carver Dual Language School, all students are expected to be truly bilingual and biliterate in both Spanish and English, by the time they complete sixth grade.

Research shows that students who attend dual language schools generally have higher overall academic performance than students who attend single language schools. Dual language students also experience and gain appreciation of other cultures.

Who can attend Carver?

Any kindergarten through sixth grade students who live within the boundaries of Kansas City Public schools may attend Carver. Students must be five years by August 1 to attend Kindergarten.

Are English Language Learners welcome to apply?

Yes! All students are welcome at Carver!

Do students have to speak a certain language to attend?

There is no language requirements to enroll in kindergarten or first grade. Students are not required to speak fluent English to enroll.

Is Carver a part of the Kansas City Public Schools?

Because it is a KCPS Signature School, Carver does not serve a specific neighborhood and students from throughout KCPS can attend the school. Free bus transportation is also provided.

Benefits of Dual Language

A dual language school provides instruction in two languages and fosters bilingualism, biliteracy, enhanced awareness of linguistic and cultural diversity and high levels of academic achievement through instruction in two languages. Kindergarten and first grade students receive classroom instruction in Spanish. This language immersion model is an excellent way for students to quickly learn a second language.
