The original Faxon Elementary, just down the street from the current building, was retired from KCPS and was remodeled to serve as senior housing for our neighbors. The current building, previously a Montessori school, now houses kindergarten through sixth grade students and offers a variety of programs and activities to engage the unique Faxon students.

Because parents are the backbone of the school, Faxon created a Parent Empowerment Group, developed to foster every family's potential by empowering parents and students through communication, collaboration, diversity, respect and accountability. In addition, Faxon hosts Parent Academy where parents can learn about the resources available through the school and Kansas City Public Schools.

Through a partnership with Scholastic, Faxon students receive 10 new books throughout the school year to create their own home library.

Partners in Learning (PALS) volunteers from around the community join our students to share the love of reading and math each week. PALS also mentor students for an extra layer of one-on-one support to nurture their growth and to support success.
