SPANISH & MANDARIN CHINESE IMMERSION

We are the premier Spanish and Mandarin Chinese language immersion program in Kansas City. We have developed a program that will help prepare our students for success learning a second language, as well as in their academic career.

Studies have shown that the brain of a young child has several areas active in language acquisition. Not only are they able to quickly pick up the second language, learning Spanish or Chinese assists in their understanding of English grammar.

Giving students a head start

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Spanish and Mandarin Chinese immersion students at FLA are adaptable and ready to interact successfully with a wide variety of people. Children who learn in a full foreign language environment consistently outperform their peers. They excel at communication, collaboration, critical thinking and creativity. Students from FLA consistently rank number one in the end-of-course Algebra I tests as well as lead the way in other traditional academic rankings.

Along with the academic benefits, learning a foreign language creates an exceptional cultural awareness of others. Providing exposure to a second language at an early age often leads to a more open and diverse global view later in life. Developing globally conscious citizens is an important part of FLA's mission.

How does it work?

Immersion is a method of instruction where regular school curriculum is taught in the target language. Using gestures, pictures and games, the teacher shows the young students how to make the connection between the object and the new word.

Through the target language, the kindergarten student will acquire reading and language, math and social studies skills. As students continue to hear the foreign language, they will begin using their target foreign language words, phrases and sentences in every day curriculum.

Spanish Immersion

Spanish is an important language within our country. A language spoken from the streets of Madrid to the foothills of the Andes, Spanish is one of the most popular languages for children in the U.S. to learn today. Plus, a rising number of employers prefer individuals who can speak Spanish fluently.
