The East Sussex School Health Service offers three programmes for reception-aged children including:

- vision screening
- the National Childhood Measurement Programme (NCMP)
- a health needs assessment (HNA) survey completed online by a child's parent or carer.

School Screener parent portal

You'll be able to view you child's results for their vision screening and NCMP measurements as well as your responses to their health needs assessment survey via our new online **School Screener parent portal**. You'll have secure, 24-hour access to all personalised data for your children with one username and password. Please register for your **School Screener parent portal** account by clicking this link https://app.schoolscreener.com/Portal/#/3232/p/ESh124/140493.

The School Health Team will be visiting your child's school in roughly two weeks' time to complete the vision screening and NCMP programmes. Further information on these programmes is attached to this email. You can register to receive results and or opt out of the programme if you would rather your child doesn't take part using this

We'll assume that you are happy for us to see your child in school if we don't hear from you.

Your child's online Health Needs Assessment (HNA) takes around 10-15 minutes to complete and can be accessed using this additional

You'll receive an email with your survey responses and this can also be viewed on your **School Screener parent portal.** A nurse will review the questionnaire and may contact you to offer health advice, information and support if needed.
