**Sculpture a la Minecraft -** Come learn new sculpture skills, but you'll be building with a twist! The base material you will be using for all the projects in this class is blocks! Students will learn how to join, construct, adhere, build, form, and finish off sculptures made from basic wooden blocks. **Create Your Own Superhero -** Are you interested in comic book art, line art, anime, or digital characters like Pokémon and more? This is the class for you! Students will learn about different types of character illustration and creation, including the media, methods, and types of drawing skills that are prevalent in the storytelling of HEROES and VILLIANS. During class, students will get to create their own hero and archnemesis, and the culminating project will be a full-size illustration of the two to take home and share. Examples of daily topics are how to draw with hatching and cross-hatching (like in comic books!), using lines and exaggeration to create the illusion of motion, and how to take a drawing and digitize it to get it onto a computer, which could lead the student into animation, video production, stop motion, and more!
