

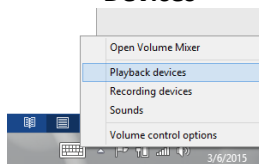
USB or Microsoft LifeChat Headphones

How to Configure USB or Microsoft LifeChat Headphones for Use

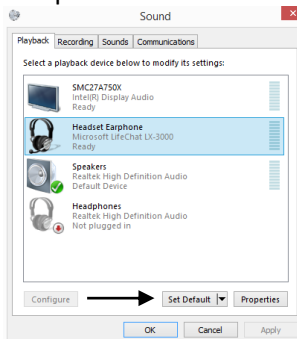
*The steps provided below only pertain to USB or **Microsoft LifeChat** headphones, (mainly used to support student accommodations for assessments). Standard headphones (1/8" jack) will not need to be set as a default device in order to function properly.**

To enable Microsoft Life Chat Headphones (these have a microphone in addition to the earphones):

1. Ensure that the headphones are connected to the device via the USB port
2. Find and right-click the volume icon near the bottom right of the screen and choose '**Playback Devices**'



3. From the Sound Menu that opens, select the '**Microsoft LifeChat**' option and then select '**Set as Default**', Click '**Apply**' and then '**OK.**' This will set your headphones as the default device on the computer.



*The best way to establish a working connection between headphones and the device is through a USB connection. 1/8" headphone jacks (the more common design for everyday use) come in a variety of tip and ring configurations that may or may not be compatible with a computer, based on the arrangement of the tip and ring format. Although most configurations will work with current computers, it is important to note that older 1/8" equipped units may not make a usable connection, which cannot be changed by the settings on the computer itself.
