

#### **Community**

The Stillwater Area Public School District is home to nearly 60,000 residents living in 18 communities in the St. Croix River valley. The district stretches 30 miles along the scenic St. Croix River, from Marine on St. Croix south to Afton, and covers approximately 150 square miles. Our family-oriented communities offer the advantages of being within 20 miles of the Twin Cities metropolitan area, while also providing a small-town environment. #### Curriculum

Stillwater Area High School offers a comprehensive curriculum of more than 176 courses, providing preparation and six-year planning for college-bound students, post-secondary vocational students and students planning to enter the workforce following graduation. The school offers a wide variety of courses to build a strong educational foundation in language arts, mathematics, social studies, science, business education, industrial technology, fine arts, health and physical education. Students have the opportunity to study several world languages. They can also gain a wide variety of technical skills in the school's Fabrication Laboratory. #### **Rigorous Course Opportunities**

Stillwater Area High School offers a six-period day. Students may enroll in three enriched (accelerated) courses: English 9 Enriched and STEM Physical Science in 9th grade and English 10 Enriched in 10th grade. These enriched courses do not reflect a weighted grade.

#### **Post-Secondary Enrollment Option**

Qualified juniors and seniors may attend eligible Minnesota post-secondary institutions with tuition, fees and textbooks paid by the school district. Tenth grade students may register for one CTE (Career and Technical Education) course through PSEO during their first semester enrolled. If they take a course during the fall semester and receive a letter grade of a "C" or higher, they may take one more CTE course during spring semester.

## **Stillwater Area High School Graduation Requirements**

The Board of Education requires a minimum of 43 credits in grades 9-12. Required classes include eight credits each in language arts and social studies, six credits each in mathematics and science, one credit each in health and physical education and two credits in fine arts. #### **Extracurricular Activities**

Stillwater Area High School students can participate in 35 MSHSL activities, 10 fine arts groups, 9 independent providers and 21 student clubs including debate, music, student government, National Honor Society, theater and other clubs (e.g. Chess, Eco-Leaders, DECA, FFA, and SADD). Newspaper and Yearbook are offered during the six period day and are co-curricular with a commitment of time required outside the school day. Students can participate in the newspaper and yearbook by enrolling in these elective courses within the six-period day.

#### **Honors and Awards**

- State and national awards for student publications for the *Kabekonian* (our yearbook), the *Pony Express* (our student newspaper), and the *Stylus* (our creative arts magazine). Awards include Kabekonian 2019-Minnesota High School Press Association Best of Show Third; Stylus-MHSPA Hall of Fame Publication; All-State Gold honors from Journalism Educators of Minnesota; Both instructors Master Journalism Educators certified by Journalism Education Association.
- Longest streak of superior ratings in the Minnesota State High School League in musical
  competitions involving the bands (Concert, Varsity, Symphonic), the orchestras (Concert,
  Varsity, Symphonic and Chamber) and the choirs (The Stillwater Choir, Varsity Men, Varsity
  Women, Belle Chanter, Vagabonds, Select Women and Sophomore Chamber Choir). Nationally
  recognized for concert performances in New Mexico, Georgia, Arizona and Illinois. Routinely
  invited to the St. Olaf Choir, Concordia and Dorian Festivals.
- Repeated recognition from the AP College Board in the 2021-2022 school year in which 89 students were named AP Scholars, 44 students were named AP Scholars with Honors, 58 students were named AP Scholars with Distinction.
- Stillwater has had 64 Minnesota State High School League State team athletic championships, including adapted sports. In 2021-2022 SAHS had 15 conference championships and 18 section titles.

#### **Grading System**

Stillwater Area High School has a dual ranking system for grading in all of our Advanced Placement (AP), College in the Schools (CIS), concurrent enrollment and Project Lead The Way (PLTW) courses. These courses are weighted with a 1.2 multiplier to establish the weighted rank. Academic letters are awarded to students who earn a GPA of 3.750 or above.

\*Grades during the second semester of the 2019-2020 school year reflect a disruption to learning during the COVID-19 pandemic. P\* indicates that credit is earned for the course and Proficient; X\* indicates that credit is earned for the course although Not Proficient. Students also had an option to receive letter grades for the semester.
