The team beat Tech 64-5 in the semi-finals to advance to the sectional championship, where they gave #8 North Central a great game before falling, 56-43. Congrats to senior Ariel Helm, who was recently selected to the All-Marion County team!



Boys Basketball:

#14 Lawrence North (12-5, 4-2 MIC) had a couple of really good wins over the weekend, beating #4 Ben Davis 63-52 and totally dominating Fort Wayne Snider, 93-53. In the BD game, C.J. Gunn led the team with 31 points, with Azavier Robinson picking up 11. In the Snider game, Gunn and Kobi Bowles had 18 each, Robinson had 15, and Omar Cooper had 9 points and 11 rebounds.
