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The meeting of January 25, 2022 was called to order by Chairman Carole Slattery at 10:00 AM. Members Present: Patty Noblet, Janet DiTarando, Carole Slattery, Bill Tyler, Roxann Lannon, Maryann Hopowiec Wes Shorts as well as Town Council member Bill Campbell and Edward Slattery. Director Maureen Gabriele was also in attendance. Absent: Ron Kane and Pat Iamonaco.

No members of the public were present either in person or on the ZOOM link.

The minutes for November 16, 2021 were moved for approval by Janet DiTarando and seconded by Patty Noblet, the motion carried unanimously.

The minutes for the Special Meeting of January 4, 2022 were moved for approval by Wes Shorts and seconded by Patty Noblet, the motion carried unanimously.

No minutes for the December meeting were presented because the meeting was cancelled.

The Treasurer's Report was presented by Wes Shorts. The total in the accounts is \$41,537.80 with a .010% APR. The reports was moved for approval by Roxann Lannon and seconded by Bill Tyler. The motion carried unanimously.

#### Committee Reports – None

Maureen Gabriele gave her report. The mask requirement within the Center is working. Members are more comfortable coming in and we have received no complaints. Maureen asked the Board to please set an example when they are in the Center to be sure they follow the rules and others will too. It is important that the Board members read the newsletter and be available to answer questions of members.

HVCC has a planned presentation providing information about the programs they offer later next month. Grab and Go Lunches are ranging between 50-70. The costs is \$5.00 an increase as of January 1, 2022, hasn't seemed to impact the numbers of participants. The proceeds from the lunch go to the non-budgetary account.

Maureen shared that they are trying to reschedule events and programs that were cancelled due to COVID. It has been difficult to do so, but the staff continues to work on it.

Chairman Carole Slattery requested during her report to change the April 26<sup>th</sup> meeting to the 19<sup>th</sup>. There were no objections so the date was changed.

The next meeting is February 22, 2022 at the Senior Center.

No new business was requested.

The meeting adjourned at 10:28 AM with a motion from Maryann Hopowiec and seconded by Wes Shorts. The motion was approved unanimously.
