**Support your House**

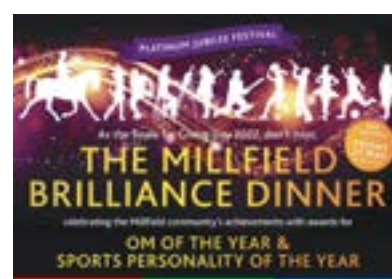

## What difference does bursary funding make to Millfield?
