If You Were Hired During the 2021-22 School Year ...

You must complete 14 hours of FCS coursework before the end of this school year.

If You Were Hired During the 2020-21 School Year...

You must complete all 28 hours of the FCS coursework by the end of this school year.

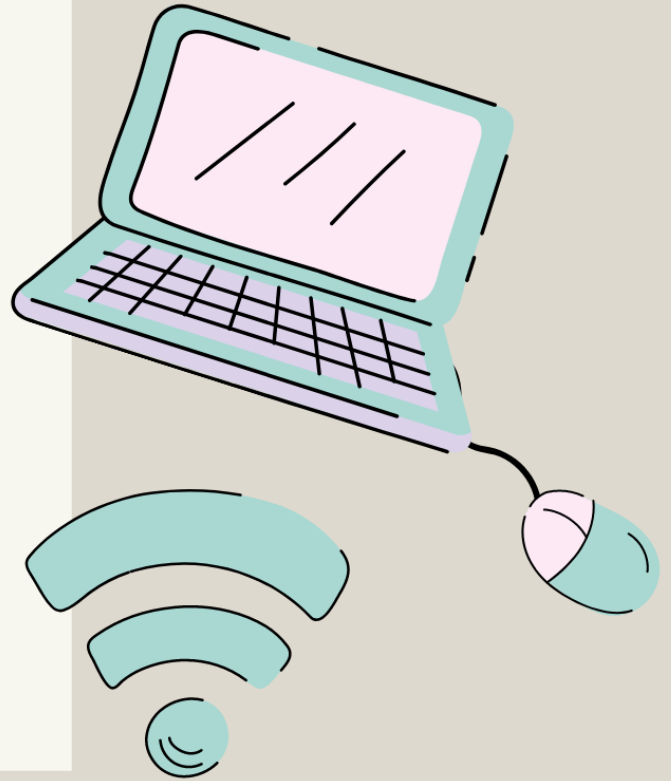
Reminder....

If you did not complete the required 14 hours of training last year due to the school closure, you are required to complete them this year AND the required 14 hours for this year

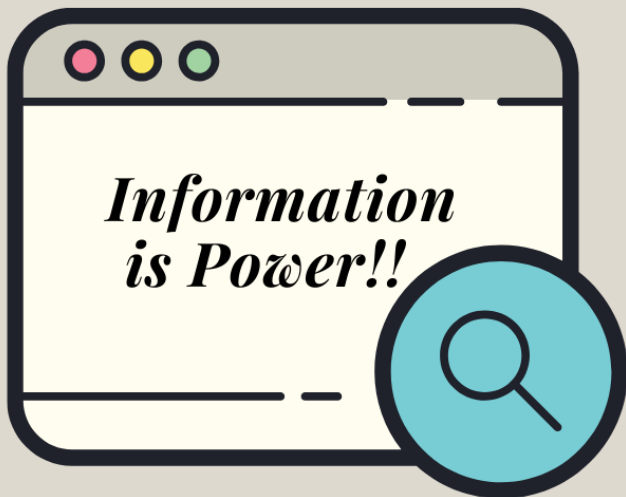
If You Were Hired In or Prior to the 2020-21 School Year...

You must complete all 28 hours of the FCS coursework AND 14 hours of the GPC program.
