

WEDNESDAY ELECTIVES 2022 - SESSION 4

Session Dates: March 2, 9, 16, 23, 30

YEARBOOK - Persistence, passion, patience and teamwork are key when putting together a yearbook that will be loved for years to come. The EAS Yearbook Committee is looking for interested students to join our 7th and 8th grade editors in creating the 2021-2022 yearbook. Students will learn to develop page layouts, copy write, photo edit and collaborate to create the final yearbook. The majority of work will occur within the elective class, however, additional tasks may be required to ensure deadlines are met. Join the yearbook team and help to create the best yearbook ever! DUNGEONS & DRAGONS - In this student led elective you will be playing a fun roleplaying game called Dungeons and Dragons. D & D is a roleplaying game in which players take on the roles of imaginary characters who engage in adventures. This elective is open for both experienced veterans and new players. You do not need to bring anything other than yourself to this elective. People have already been selected to run the campaigns and there will be three separate campaigns: a five-person campaign, a six-person campaign, and an eight-person campaign. You will have the choice of which campaign you would like to play in. Hope to see you there.

FIELD GAMES - Time to get outdoors and have fun being active. The goal is to play Muggle Quidditch, Ultimate Frisbee, Capture the Flag, Field Day Games, and kickball, of course! Since sessions will be slightly longer, treats shall be provided to refuel and keep our energy levels high. The fun we shall have rain or shine! While teaching kids how to properly train, he also educates on how the human body works (science & nutrition), brings in a little sense of humor & enjoys adding some fun challenges. FUN AND POPULAR MATH - In this elective, students will explore real world topics using practical math such as:

1. Compound Interest. The 8th wonder of the world. How to make a million dollars, 10 million, a billion?
2. Do you have what it takes to engineer and build your own house?
3. How to be a trip planning ninja.
4. How to plan and throw the best parties for life.

The parent instructors are looking forward to exploring these topics with you and even have fun prizes along the way!

DRAWING AND PAINTING - Students will explore a variety of drawing and painting techniques including still life, gesture drawing, watercolor, sketching, and collage. Each class will be something new with the last two classes to be determined by student interests. A supply fee of \$5-\$10 will be collected.

BOWLING AT TECHCITY BOWL - Whether you bowl a perfect strike or need to work on your gutter ball come have some bowling fun at Techcity Bowl! All levels of bowlers are welcome. Students will bowl from approximately 11:10-12:10 each week. Students will choose bowling groups each week. CROSS STITCHING - Come learn the art of cross-stitch. Design and create your own cross-stitch project from scratch! Participants will create their own unique pattern, and then use cross stitching and back stitching on Aida fabric to produce a work of embroidered art suitable for gifting and display. No sewing or embroidery skills needed.

MAGIC THE GATHERING & BOARD GAMES - Come join this fun and popular elective suitable for everyone. Each week there will be a variety of board games available to learn and play. Or, students have the choice to bring their Magic The Gathering cards and play with others. Class taught by Eric Battisti of Tolarian Scholars Northwest. Eric has taught several enrichment classes at EAS as well as other afterschool programs. Eric is a Magic the Gathering expert as well as provides a variety of new and fun board games for students. A class fee of \$20-\$25 will be collected, depending on number of students signed up.
