
The legal voters of the Town of Cambridge are hereby warned and notified to meet in the Cambridge Memorial Gymnasium in Jeffersonville within said Town on Tuesday, March 1, 2022, to act on the following articles by Australian ballot. The polls for the Australian ballot will open at 7:00 AM on Tuesday, March 1, 2022, and will remain open until 7:00 PM.

The voters are further notified that an informational meeting about the Australian ballot questions will be held by virtual meeting at 6:00 PM on Monday, February 28, 2022, using the following connection information:



- Article 1 Shall the Cambridge Town School District pay its School Board Directors for the year ensuing at a rate of \$1,500 for each director and \$1,800 for the chair?
- Article 2 To elect a School Board Director for the Cambridge Elementary School, for a term of three (3) years.
- Article 3 To elect a School Board Director for the Cambridge Elementary School, for a term of two (2) years.
- Article 4 To elect a School Board Director for the Lamoille North Modified Unified Union School District, for a term of three (3) years.
- Article 5 Shall the voters of Cambridge Town School District authorize the Board of School Directors for the Cambridge Elementary School to hold the audited fund balance as of June 30, 2021, in the amount of \$122,408, to be expended under the control and direction of the Board of School Directors for the purpose of future unfunded student focused pandemic recovery efforts?
- Article 6 Shall the Cambridge Town School District approve the proposed budget for the twelve months, ending June 30, 2023, in the amount of \$6,351,467, which is the amount determined to be necessary for the ensuing year? It is estimated that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in education spending of \$18,593 per equalized pupil. This projected spending per equalized pupil is 8.86% higher than spending for the current year.




