English

In English this week, the pupils will be continuing to read this term's focus text 'The Secret of Black Rock' by Joe Stanton.

The pupils will be making predictions and inferences, as well as exploring the feelings of the main character Erin Pike. The pupils will then use their knowledge to write a diary entry in role.



Maths

In Maths this week, the pupils will be consolidating their understanding of how to identify $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of a number or shape, and know that all parts must be equal parts of the whole.
