



Peripatetic Music Lessons

The Performing Arts Department at Coombe Wood School continue to work with Croydon Music and Arts (CMA) offering a programme of peripatetic instrumental/vocal music lessons.

Last year CWS students took part in guitar, drum, woodwind, violin, piano and vocal lessons with some students participating in exams. CMA will organise and provide specialist teachers who will teach instrumental or vocal lessons, either individually or in pairs for up to half an hour every week. Lessons will take place during the school day and are done on a rotational basis to ensure that the students will not miss parts of the same lesson every week.

Once your child starts in September Head of Performing Arts Miss Legrange will send out a letter and CMA application form with details on lesson types (individual or paired), costings and discounts available.

If your child is interested in learning or continuing lessons, please complete the form in September and return it to their Music teacher or the Performing Arts Office.
