- Teacher Student Success Plan 2022-2023 Discussion

School Goals:

1. Academic – decrease learning gap between Sunset and the state average in English, Math, and Science by 2%. As measured by 2023 end of level assessments.
2. Graduation Goal – increase number of students in class 2026 that are on track – reducing number of classes failed by 3% - as compared to 8th grade year.
3. SEL/Social Learning – Implement new weekly SEL curriculum lesson during RAP.

Connie Stanger proposals:

1. Use Trustland funds to purchase an ESL tutor
2. Give teachers opportunity to apply for grant to help meet school goals
 - a. Use Trustland funds/TSSA – amount --\$20,000?
 - b. Will give us the Google form to apply
 - c. Jackman likes this idea and would like to implement this year
 - d. Jackman said that teachers did have opportunity to apply for \$1000

Mr Jackman monies plans:

1. Goal 1 = \$60,000 Trustland funds for trackers/\$60,000 for productivities
 - a. Want to hire new Spanish speaking tracker that could potentially help in the library for a Lunch program

- Lunch and Learn Update

Amy Poff report:

1. Purpose of Lunch and Learn is to help students take tests, retake, get caught up on homework
2. Teachers request students to come down
3. Students get out 5 min. early to get lunch and go down to do the work
4. 800 assignments were made up 1st and 2nd term, currently 186.
5. Room typically has 5 to 30 kids a day
6. Math and English tutor is there on Wednesdays
7. Amy uses an Excel spreadsheet to track – teachers have access to this form
8. Many visitors ask to go and hang out



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- Standards Based Grading Update
 1. Next year the plan is to increase teacher application/commitment to Standards Based Grading
 2. Research supports this type of grading gives a more accurate picture of what is missing.
