Extreme Weather

Pupils at Clifton High School wear a uniform, which is distinctive and most importantly recognises them as a member of the school community. Our uniform means that pupils do not have to worry about peer pressure as everyone is dressed the same, generating a sense of belonging and identity. The wearing of a uniform prepares pupils for adulthood and the world of work.

Every pupil is expected to dress in accordance with the School Uniform Policy at all times. Pupils are ambassadors for the School when in uniform, both on and off the school premises. Any requests for deviations to the Uniform Policy must be made to the Infant and Junior School Head.

## Uniform Standards – Junior School

- **Blazers** are to be worn to and from school and in school as directed
- **Shirts** must be tucked in and fully buttoned
- **Shoes** should be a formal, black leather or leather substitute with no logos. They should be well-fitting and support the feet. Shoes with a canvas upper, soft-soled ballet pumps or black trainers of any kind are not allowed. Shoes should be clean and polished
- **Socks** should be dark in colour for boys and girls. In the summer term, girls can wear white socks with their sandals. In the winter, tights should be navy. Trainer socks are not to be worn
- **Skirts/Kilts** should be knee-length or just above
- **Clifton High Sports kit** on days where PE or Games is timetabled, pupils can wear their regulation PE kit to and from School. Pupils' are expected to wear their regulation training pants and their regulated soft-shell jacket over their t-shirts and shorts/skort. Clothing from other sports retailers, clubs or associations is not permitted
- **Hair** below shoulder length is to be tied back with a simple blue or black accessory or a summer blue and white striped accessory, to prevent accidents and in the interest of hygiene. Hair should be neat and a natural colour and we do not permit extreme hair styles.
- **Jewellery** is limited to a watch, small stud earrings (maximum one in each ear) and, if desired, a fine chain with a religious symbol appropriate to the wearer. Pupils wearing inappropriate or additional jewellery will be asked to remove it

### Uniform Standards – Infant School

- **Polo Shirts** are to be worn by Reception and Year 1 pupils
- **Shirts** to be worn by Year 2 boys and girls with buttons done up, with an open neck. Shirts must be tucked in
- **Shoes** should be a formal, black leather or leather substitute with no logos. They should be well-fitting and support the feet. Shoes with a canvas upper, soft-soled ballet pumps or black trainers of any kind are not allowed. Pupils should be able to put their school shoes on and take them off, independently, and trainers, for PE and sport, should have a Velcro fastening. Summer Sandals can be worn with white socks in the Summer Term
- **Socks** should be dark in colour for boys and girls. In the summer term, girls can wear white socks with their sandals. In the winter, tights should be navy. Trainer socks are not to be worn
- **Clifton High Sports kit** can be worn to and from school on days that pupils have PE lessons and Games lessons. Pupils are only to wear Clifton High Sports kit, clothing from other sports retailers, clubs or associations is not permitted
- **Hair** below shoulder length is to be tied back with a simple blue or black accessory or a summer blue and white striped accessory, to prevent accidents and in the interest of hygiene. Hair should be neat and a natural colour and we do not permit extreme hair styles
- **Jewellery** is limited to a watch, small stud earrings (maximum one in each ear) and, if desired, a fine chain with a religious symbol appropriate to the wearer. Pupils wearing inappropriate or additional jewellery will be asked to remove it
- **Waterproof clothing** High wellies, waterproof trousers/dungarees and a waterproof jacket should be in school at all times for Reception pupils

### Uniform Standards – The Hive

- **Jumpers and Polo shirts** are to be Clifton High School branded
- **Trousers** should be navy, dark grey or black
- **Shoes** should be well-fitting and support the feet
- **Waterproof clothing** High wellies, waterproof trousers/dungarees and a waterproof jacket should be in school at all times
- **Hair** below shoulder length is to be tied back with a simple blue or black accessory or a summer blue and white striped accessory, to prevent accidents and in the interest of hygiene
- **School coats** should be navy or black with no logos

### **Labelling of Clothing**

All clothing and major items of equipment must be marked with the pupil's full name.

### **Second-Hand Uniform Shop**

The second-hand uniform shop is run by the Admissions Team, in the Main School Building. Parents can contact the admissions department by email to request items; if the requested items are available, they will then be made available to collect from the School Office by pupils/parents. The charge will then be added to their school bill. Items can be taken home to try, providing they are either returned or paid for the following day.

Uniform will be accepted into the Second-hand Uniform Shop to sell that is clean, in good repair and conforming to the current uniform list. Blazers and coats should be dry-cleaned or washed. Articles are priced depending on condition. The School retains 20% commission on the sale price and the remainder is credited to parents via their school bill. Any items remaining unsold after one year are given to charity. The Admissions Team can be emailed to discuss availability of sizes, handing in/selling/purchasing uniform on.
