Teacher Education Licensure

The College of Menominee Nation Early Childhood / Middle Childhood Education Program focuses on preparing teachers, increasing the diversity of teachers in Wisconsin and responding to underserved geographic areas (rural reservations) particularly in understaffed content areas such as mathematics and science. The Early Childhood / Middle Childhood Education Program prepares teachers to know, understand, implement, and assess the cultural experiences of all children, especially American Indian children. Graduates of the program are prepared to help children understand the legacy of caring for their natural surroundings and protecting natural resources and their relationships with others.

Teacher licensure rates are provided below. The results should be interpreted with caution due to small class sizes. Overall, nearly 70% of teacher education candidates applied for and received their teaching licenses.
