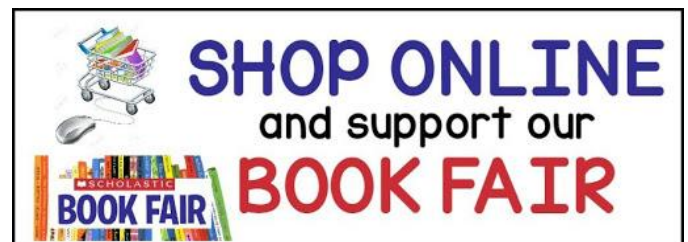

BIKE HELMET SAFETY TIPS

- Buy a helmet that fits your child now. Don't buy a helmet that they will grow into or use a hand-me-down.
- The helmet should sit level on the top of the head - if you look up with it on, you should be able to see the front of the helmet.
 - The rim should be one to two finger-widths above the eyebrows.
 - Make sure the straps of the helmet form a "V" under the ears when buckled. The strap should be snug but comfortable.
 - Have your child open their mouth as wide as they can. Does the helmet feel like it's hugging their head? If not, tighten those straps and make sure the buckle is flat against their skin.
- If it is the correct size, it will not move sideways, forward or backward when on. This is particularly important so that the head is protected as much as possible in the instance of a crash or collision.
