

Verification of Student Safe Schools Data Reporting

Note: For bullying rising to the level of prohibited harassment, see FFH. For all other bullying, see FFI. For the transfer of a student who is the victim of bullying or who engaged in bullying, including a student who receives special education services, see FDB. For transfers of students who are the victim of a violent criminal offense, see FDE.

Verification of Student Discipline Data Reporting

Campus principals shall verify in writing to the IMS/PEIMS Department at the end of each grading period whether the campus has accurately entered into the electronic student discipline data system all student discipline information reportable to TEA through PEIMS.

Verification of Letter to Victims of Violent Criminal Offenses

Per FDE(LOCAL), campus principals shall verify at the end of each grading period that school safety transfers have been offered in writing, within 14 days of the incident, to any student who becomes a victim of one of the following violent criminal offenses, as defined by the Penal Code, while on the premises of the school the student attends or while attending a school-sponsored or school-related activity, on or off school property:

- a. Attempted murder;
- b. Indecency with a child;
- c. Aggravated kidnapping;
- d. Aggravated assault on someone other than a District employee or volunteer;
- e. Sexual assault or aggravated sexual assault against someone other than a District employee or volunteer;
- f. Aggravated robbery; or
- g. Continuous sexual abuse of a young child or children.

Victim Letter Procedure

Campus principals shall be responsible for ensuring that the victim letter procedure is followed for victims of the any of the above offenses on campus. [See FDE(EXHIBIT)]
