Dr. Lorey introduced Mr. Jarrod Land and We the People students who competed in the State competition in December. The students who competed were—Marianna Green, Kevin Dominguez, Abe Eckman, Alexis Kleiman, Tarynn Reeves, Samantha Fleishaker, Hannah Seifert, Megan Rydberg, Livia Land and Hallie Hubert.

Mr. Land stated that Mr. Buechlein got him interested in the program. He started out as a judge and decided to implement it at Jasper High School. The kids study the Constitution and debate on it. He stated it is a nation wide program and the program is growing at Jasper High School. He would like to

see the program started at Jasper Middle School. The students are in a room with the judges and they debate the topics.

He thanked Dr. Lorey, Mr. Buechlein and Mr. Eckerle for coming and supporting the students.

Dr. Lorey stated she is impressed with the preparedness of the students. Some other teams competing have three times the students on the team. Our students have to have knowledge in more areas of the Constitution than other teams who have more members. Dr. Lorey presented Mr. Land and the students with a Certificate for their achievement.

Mr. Eckerle stated they were one of twelve schools in the entire state competing. Our students were competing against larger schools. He credited them with their passion and willingness to take this on. These students can change the government and make it better. He stated it makes him proud.

Curriculum Update-Mrs. Fawks

She was not present but Dr. Lorey informed the Board of the following:

- Update the Board on Covid-19 School Operations Plan for ESSER Purposes
 - The US Department of Education requires that school districts review and allow for public comment on the return to in-person instruction plans otherwise known as our Covid-19 school operations plan semi-annually
 - The district revised the Covid-19 school operations plan on January 4 to align with recent changes to isolation and quarantine periods for students and staff by the CDC. The plan was shared with parents and staff and is posted on the corporation website
 - In general, the corporation continues to monitor both the county color designated by the ISDH and their own internal percent of positive Covid cases in each school. Regardless of the county color, positive cases below 4% of the total enrollment in any school will result in a masks recommended status. If positive cases reach 4% or higher, a two week mask mandate will be implemented in the impacted location
 - The isolation and quarantine periods have been reduced to 5 days. Positive students or staff may return on day 6 and wear a mask through day 10. If wearing the mask is problematic, they may opt for the 10 day quarantine
 - Close contacts are required to quarantine for 5 days and may return on day 6.

Dr. Lorey asked if there were any comments or questions regarding the update.

There were no comments made.

- Report on Educate Dubois County event held on Monday, January 17
 - The educate Dubois County Professional Development Day was held at Jasper High School. Over 400 teachers from Dubois County attended the event. The keynote address was presented by Brian Dinkins. Teachers were able to opt for 3 of 65 breakout sessions available. Grade level and departmental networking time was provided and special sessions were provided for training of special education staff on assistive technology. A motion by Ken Schnaus, second by Greg Eckerle, to approve the Conflict of Interest for Arlet Jackle was voted 4-0 with Mrs. Jackle abstaining from the vote.

A motion by Greg Eckerle, second by Arlet Jackle, to approve the Conflict of Interest for Robert Schitter, was voted 5-0.

Dr. Lorey updated the Board on the Preliminary Determination for projects subject to referendum status and next steps in the lease financing process. She stated the 30 day preliminary determination period ended. She stated no petitions were requested. As a result, the corporation is moving ahead with the next phase of the funding process. Appraisal proceedings will begin in early February.

Dr. Lorey asked the Board to approve Jasper Parks Department to use the Cabby Gym to expand winter indoor programming. Times would be Monday-Friday from 8:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.

Tom Moorman from the Parks Department stated there is a need for a place to hold indoor activities like pickle ball, volleyball, basketball, and day time walking. He stated staff will be there to supervise.

Mr. Vogler stated that time of day sometimes volunteers are in the gym doing work and they will need to coordinate their schedules. He stated it is really good to have the Parks Department using the facility.

A motion by Tim DeMotte, second by Ken Schnaus, to approve Jasper Parks Department the use of Cabby Gym, was unanimously approved by the Board.




There being no further business to conduct and upon a motion by Tim DeMotte, second by Greg Eckerle, the Board voted to adjourn at 7:37 p.m.


