Tournament Games are open to the public and are subject to MIAA supervision and regulations. We want MC fans to provide only **positive support** for our team and **courtesy** for our opponents. All players on both teams have worked hard to get there and deserve respect. We fully expect sportsmanlike conduct by players and by our fans.

Specifically, please observe these guidelines:

- Please sit with MC fans. Don't stray from the tournament site.
- Cheers should be in support of our **team** (not naming individuals), should be positive, and not ever against opposing individual players, teams, or coaches, nor directed at officials.
- Attention should stay focused on **team** action on the court , not on fan actions in the stands.
- Noisemakers are not allowed. Shirts required.
- Do not boo or yell at officials.
- Please be reminded that improper behavior by others does not give you permission to use similarly improper behavior. Two wrongs don't make a right.
- Do not make noise during free-throws; chanting "air-ball" is not clever; it's inappropriate.
- We ask our parents and alumni, also, to display positive example and sportsmanship.
- Stay off the floor, in stands, until players have left the court. No spectators are permitted on the floor or locker room.

Taunting includes any actions or comments by coaches, players, or spectators which are intended to bait, anger, embarrass, ridicule, or demean others, whether or not the words are vulgar or racist. Included is conduct that berates, needles, intimidates, or threatens based on race, gender, or ethnic origin, or background, and conduct that attacks religious beliefs, size, economic status, speech, family, special needs, or personal matters.
