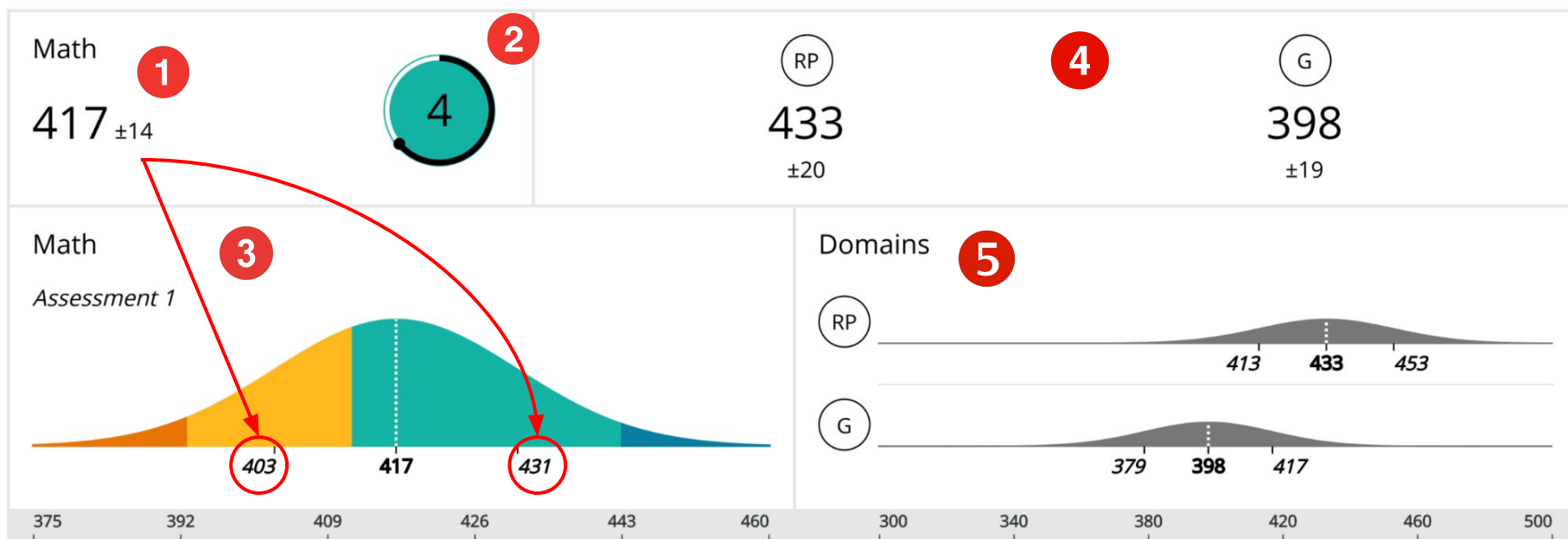


SAMPLE LRIA REPORT (MATH)

Assessment 1



- 1** The overall student score indicates the student's score and standard error of measurement on the single test in that subject.

The circular chart color represents the student's estimated performance level. The Performance Levels are aligned to those in the Illinois Assessment of Readiness. This sample report indicates that the score places the student in performance level 4. This means that the student is likely to be meeting grade level expectations for the standards that were assessed. The black band around the outside of the circle is the confidence band. On this report, it extends about 65% around the circle, indicating the likelihood that the student would be placed in this performance level if the test was taken again.
- 2** These numbers indicate the student's score and standard error of measurement for each of the domains tested. See the back of this report for domains tested at each grade level for Math and English Language Arts.
- 3** The graph provides a visual display of the student's score and where it is situated relative to nearby performance levels. Not all performance levels are necessarily represented on the graph. The curve of the graph is representing the relative likelihood of scoring within the levels displayed. In this sample, the standard error of measurement (+/- 14) for this student's score extends into the "Approach Expectations" level.
- 4** The charts display the full range of possible scores (300-500) and the student's score within the range of likely scores on the domain. This chart has much more utility after the second administration of the assessment, where the current and new scores will be displayed.
