S.T.A.R Program

Therapeutic Program for Students in Need of Extra Support



Services Provided:

- Cognitive-Behavior Group Therapy
- Dialectical-Behavior Group Therapy
- Processing Group Therapy
- Individual Sessions
- Creative therapeutic activities
- Collaboration with Collier teaching staff to develop a plan that reengages the student academically, and keeps students up-to-date with school work
- Program and transition planning for their return to school

The S.T.A.R. program (Skills Training and Retention) is a two-week therapeutic intensive program tailored to Collier High School and Middle School students who are highly motivated to be at Collier but have difficulty reaching or maintaining the standard of behavior and attendance expected at the school.

While in S.T.A.R., students and counselors will address the student's underlying needs. Students gain the skills necessary to become and remain healthy and productive members of the Collier community. Having this program on campus provides seamless continuity of care and services for our students both clinically and academically.
