Dear Parents and Guardians,

The Board of Directors at Vancouver College sets the tuition fees annually based on projected revenues and operating costs. At its meeting yesterday evening, the VC Board set the fees for the 2022-2023 school year at \$8,600 per student, increasing by \$200 (2.38%).

This increase will allow the school to continue implementation of our multi-year K to 12 technology plan as well as our long-term program to maintain or even reduce class sizes. With the post-pandemic re-opening of our extracurricular program, we are excited about resuming a full slate of these activities next year. We are also keen to implement our new wellness program intended to serve all students across our campus. Finally, the level of tuition increase also reflects the funding of overall gradual increases in many expenses involved in the regular operation of the school.

The Board is grateful to the Administrative team and all Faculty who, throughout ongoing changes and challenges of COVID-19 health restrictions and protocols, have worked continually to engage your sons in meaningful, faith-based learning.

Vancouver College remains committed to providing accessible Catholic-based education to all families through our strong Financial Assistance Program. We sincerely encourage families who need help meeting tuition costs to apply for assistance. Financial Assistance information and application forms are available on the school website or from Kelly Lattimer, Director of Finance & Facilities, through a confidential process.

The Administration, faculty, and staff of Vancouver College are dedicated to helping each boy within our school community be the best he can be. On behalf of my colleagues on the Board, thank you for your ongoing support of Vancouver College.
