## **Student Expulsion**

President Eladio Quintanilla and trustee Virginia Riggs were absent. She read a letter that she stated both she and the student wrote to the board expressing the child's wishes to remain online throughout the remainder of this school year. The Father stated that the child is currently living with each parent for one week. Both parents stated that they have the child in counseling.

Student Discipline Decision: Motion by John Ferguson and supported by Kim Schemp to expel the student from physically attending Genesee School District and all events for 180 school days due to the various Code of Conduct offenses shared with us this evening. The student will continue to receive online classes through the Genesee School District. If the parents wish to bring the student back face-to-face after the 180 school days, they must request a Board hearing.
