From the Principal

Later this spring, our staff will be working together to establish class rosters for next school year. Our class placement process will be a team effort done with great care. Our intention is to carefully balance classes according to:

- Boy-girl ratio
- Academic performance
- Social-emotional development
- Special learning needs

As you can see, there are many considerations when making class placements to achieve a balance. We use a team approach in our decision, and as always parents are part of our team. If you have information you wish to share about your child, it will be added as **one** of many pieces of information for consideration in placement.

- *Do not assume because a sibling had a certain teacher that your next child will have the same teacher. That is not a consideration in class placement.*
- *Your letter is one piece of information. It will be considered but will not guarantee placement with a specific teacher.*

You may submit an email to jennifermorgan@smsd.org for consideration that provides the following information about your child:

- **Social or emotional issues with other classmates (if there has been a social issue in the past you need to write an email every year with that information)**
- **Specific learning style of your child**
- **Letters are due NO LATER THAN Friday, March 25, 2022**
- **Individual teachers may not be requested**
- **You must submit a separate letter for each child**
- **You will receive an email from me, so you have confirmation I received your email.**

Please be assured that with or without an email from parents, as professionals, the experience and knowledge we gain from working daily with your children allows us to make well-informed decisions in the best interests of the children. The staff will review each child's needs individually and select the classroom in which we believe he/she will learn the best.

Illness Prevention

In addition to COVID-19, influenza season is upon us. Please remember – and remind your children of – the following steps to help prevent the spread of illness:

- Wash hands frequently and thoroughly – scrub with soap for 20 seconds, long enough to sing the Happy Birthday song 2 times
- Cough and sneeze into your elbow or a tissue
- STAY HOME when you are sick to prevent the spread of viruses & bacteria. Follow the exclusion policies for influenza and other illnesses
- Get a flu vaccine
- Do not touch your eyes, nose, mouth throughout the day

REMINDER TO REPORT INFLUENZA

Please report all cases of diagnosed influenza to the OPC Nurse's office. The information needed is:

- Date of diagnosis
- Was a flu shot received and what date was it given?
- Type of influenza (A, B, AB)

The exclusion criteria are as follows: Persons with a case of influenza should stay home for five days from the time the illness begins or until the individual is fever free for 24 hours without the aid of fever reducing medications, whichever is longer. *OPC is following these criteria strictly, to reduce the spread of illness.*

General Illness Exclusion Policies

To protect your child and to prevent illness from spreading, keep your child home if ANY of these contagious symptoms are present:

- **Temperature of 100 degrees or higher**
- **Severe sore throat, headache, or cough**
- **Undiagnosed rash or skin lesions**
- **Diarrhea or vomiting**
- **Red or discharging eyes**
- ****Students must be free of fever, vomiting, or diarrhea – WITHOUT MEDICINE - for 24 hours before returning to school.**

BRING THOSE WATER BOTTLES!

Every student needs to bring a water bottle to school every day! Keeping hydrated is important for maintaining good health as well as recovering from illness and feeling better in general. Please help your child(ren) remember to bring their water bottle **each and every** day!

WINTER RECESS

The SMSD district recess policy is that all students will go outside if the regular temp is above 15 degrees and the windchill is above 0. We will not allow students to stay indoors for recess unless they have a documented health condition and note from a healthcare provider (doctor or nurse practitioner) stating the student must stay inside for recess. A note from a parent is not adequate. Please make sure your student has proper outdoor attire: coat, hat and gloves during the winter months.

Una nota de los padres no es suficiente. Por favor, asegúrese de que su estudiante tenga una vestimenta apropiada al aire libre: abrigos, gorros y guantes durante los meses del invierno.

REMINDER ABOUT ATTENDANCE REPORTING GUIDELINES

Parents, if your child is going to be late or absent, please call the 24/7 attendance hotline: the number is (913) 993-4188. Please try to do this by 8:30 a.m. the morning of the absence. Please note that the nurse does not do attendance or receive these messages. If you need to discuss a specific issue with her, first report the absence to the hotline, then call the nurse directly at (913) 993-4102. Alerting the teacher is appreciated, however we also require that you report the absence to the hotline. Thank you for your diligence in this matter. The safety and accountability for your children are of the utmost importance to us.

District Policy on *Returned Checks*

The district has a returned check policy that began June 1, 2007. **All returned checks are processed by a collection agency and a \$30 fee is assessed for each returned item to cover the cost of these services.** This is in addition to any charges assessed by your bank. Since the charge is being assessed by the agency for their service, the charge cannot be waived. You may want to ask your local bank about overdraft protection services.
