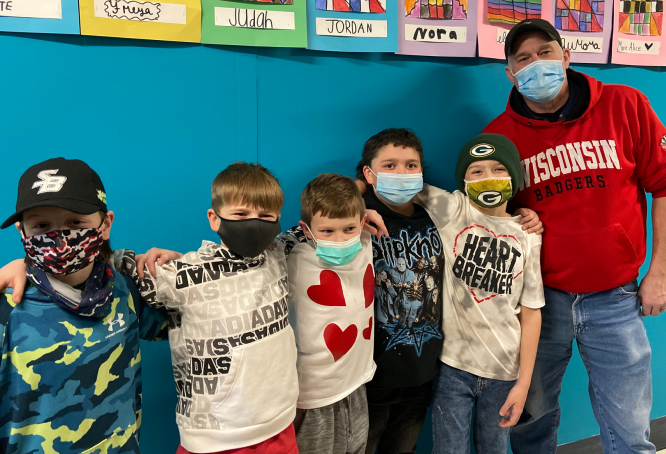

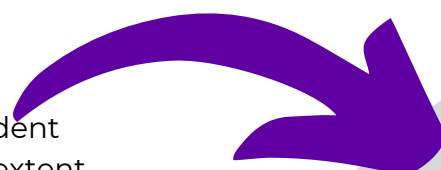
Deadline & Selection

The deadline to apply is April 10, 2022.

All materials submitted as part of the Superintendent application will remain confidential to the fullest extent allowed by law, which includes review in a closed session. After all applications have been reviewed and preliminary interviews conducted by the consulting firm, the names of the top candidates will be presented to the Stoughton Area School District Board of Education for consideration. Selection of candidates for interviews is the sole responsibility of the Board of Education.

Persons wishing to be considered for the position should submit an application file online which includes:

- Letter of application stating personal qualifications, experiences, and reasons for interest in the position;
- Online application form and resume; and
- Four current letters of recommendation
