Applicants must meet minimum requirements to be accepted for entrance in the Lottery Pool

(please see attached criteria)

- Lottery pulled applicants for acceptance (2022–2023) will be notified by email or telephone
- Final acceptance for the 2022-2023 school year will be **contingent** upon final grades, discipline and attendance, in May/June. Parent will be responsible for providing final grades, attendance and discipline report to University Preparatory office or email it to lwarnett@vvuhsd.org. If there is no discipline to report, you will need a letter confirming this on school letterhead
- Each qualified applicant will be given an application number
- Each grade level will be separated for their own vacancy pool
- Principal designee will pull application numbers for each vacancy spot, per grade level, until all spots are filled
- Principal designee will continue to pull applicant numbers for wait list, for each grade level
- Wait list will be posted, by application number, on our website at up.vvuhsd.org
- Wait list will only be valid for that school year. All applicants not accepted must reapply for the next school year

ADMISSION PRIORITIES/SIBLINGS

1. Siblings of current UP students or of siblings who graduated 2020 and 2021 (siblings must share a common, qualified address, including step sibling). This does not include extended family unless guardianship papers have been processed through the court system and are submitted.
2. Children of Victor Valley Union High School District employees. (must show proof by birth certificate)

ADMISSION GUIDELINES

We appreciate your interest in enrolling your student at University Preparatory. University Preparatory is a public school of choice that requires all of its students to adhere to a strict uniform policy. Parents/guardian are responsible to provide their own uniform. Dress code specifics will follow once accepted.

Be aware that uniforms may become costly.

Students are required to take performing arts, instruments will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian.

We do not have student transportation.

In order to qualify for the lotter your student must meet the following guidelines:

- **Applicants for 7th – 9th grade** must have a **G.P.A. of 2.5 or higher (report card will be reviewed for acceptance/eligibility). Absolutely no suspensions or excessive discipline allowed.** Final acceptance will be contingent on 3rd trimester or 2nd semester grades and discipline report (you must submit the final report card and discipline report to University Preparatory by June 30th).
- **Applicants for 10th – 12th** must have a **G.P.A. of 3.0 or higher and transcripts will be reviewed for eligibility. Absolutely no suspensions or excessive discipline allowed.** Final acceptance will be contingent on 2nd semester grades and discipline report (you must submit the final report card and discipline report to University Preparatory by June 30th).
- Minimal or no discipline from previous school(s).
- **ABSOLUTELY NO SUSPENSIONS** (since Jan. 2021)
- 90% positive attendance

HOW TO CALCULATE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL GPA

IF GRADING IS 1-5, ADD ALL THE NUMBERS, DIVIDE BY HOW MANY NUMBERS YOU ADDED, MULTIPLY BY .8 = THE GPA

EXAMPLE: $4+5+3+2+3 = 17$ divide by 5 = 3.4 multiply by .8 = 2.72 GPA

IF GRADING IS 1-4, ADD ALL THE NUMBERS AND DIVIDE BY HOW MANY NUMBERS YOU ADDED
