

Proof of Residency Procedures

To be enrolled in Viewmont High School, guardian(s) must present **TWO forms of documentation** showing that their primary residence lies within the Viewmont boundaries (see below for acceptable forms of documentation).

If your student has a sibling currently attending Viewmont for which Proof of Residency has already been presented, we will consider the prior documentation to be sufficient for this student.

Acceptable documentation needs to be dated within the past 60 days and would include:

- Rental / Lease Agreement
- Purchase / Escrow Agreement
- Utility bill (gas, electric, home telephone, cable, etc)
- Letter from government agency
- Payroll stub
- Bank or Credit Card statement
- Valid Driver's License
- Current vehicle registration or insurance
- Valid Utah photo identification card
- Medical billing or insurance information
- W-2 form (dated within the past year)
- Property tax bill (dated within the past year)

If you are living with another family, please provide a notarized statement from the person you are living with stating that you and your child(ren) live there. Be sure to include the address on the document along with what period of time you will be living at that residence. Then, along with the notarized statement, you will also need to bring TWO forms of their proof of residency at that address (see list of acceptable documentation above). If the living situation is temporary, once you have moved into your own home, you will need to bring in proof of residency for your new home. There is a notary public and statement forms available here at the school, if needed.
