

Board Minutes
October 15, 2019

The Johnson County Board of Education met in regular session on Tuesday, October 15, 2019 in the board office at 6:00 p.m. Kevin Brantley, Donald Smith, Chris Fields, Alvin P. Moorman, and Marty Thompson were present. Mr. Brantley called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone. Mr. Thompson gave the invocation and Mr. Smith led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

The following business was transacted:

1. The proposed agenda was approved on a motion by Mr. Fields, second by Mr. Smith; unanimous approval.
2. The September 17, 2019 regular meeting minutes were approved on a motion by Mr. Thompson, second by Mr. Fields; unanimous approval.
3. The September 2019 financial report was approved on a motion by Mr. Fields, second by Mr. Thompson; unanimous approval.
4. The following field trips were unanimously approved on a motion by Mr. Fields, second by Mr. Moorman:

5. Mr. Charles Howard, JCES Principal, presented the State of the School. He was excited to announce CCRPI scores were up. He commended his staff for the hard work and dedication to make this happen. He said, “I am very proud of my staff, they work extremely hard and are receptive to putting new things in place to help the students.” He announced that a representative from the Georgia Department of Education would be at JCES on November 18, 2019 for a parent involvement segment. After discussion, a motion was made to come out of executive session by Mr. Moorman, second by Mr. Thompson; unanimous approval.
