Entering Grade 11

World History - Advanced Placement (AP)

Students currently enrolled in US History - AP who achieve a grade of B- or higher may continue in the Honors sequence.

Students earning a final grade of A- or higher in US 2 - Level 1 may seek placement to World History - AP by attaining the following criteria:

- Teacher recommendation based on demonstrated achievement/ability as evidenced by classroom performance and/or assessments
- Final Grade of A- or higher in English 2 - Level 1

World History - Level 1

Students currently enrolled in US History 2 - Level 1 who achieve a grade of B- or higher may continue in the Accelerated sequence.

Students earning a final grade of A- or higher in US 2 - Level 2 may seek placement to World History - Level 1 by attaining the following criteria:

- Teacher recommendation based on demonstrated achievement/ability as evidenced by classroom performance and/or assessments
- Final Grade of A- in English 2 - Level 2

World History - Level 2

- All students may enroll in Academic Level Courses.

STUDENTS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO TAKE A FOURTH YEAR OF SOCIAL STUDIES IN 12th GRADE, THOUGH IT IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED THAT THEY DO SO.

Entering Grade 11 or Grade 12

American Government & Politics - Advanced Placement (AP)

Students currently enrolled in World History - AP who achieve a grade of B- or higher may continue in the Honors sequence.

Students earning a final grade of A or higher in US History 2 - Level 1 or World History - Level 1 may seek placement in American Government & Politics - AP by attaining the following criteria:

- Teacher recommendation based on demonstrated achievement/ability as evidenced by classroom performance and/or assessments
- For 10th graders: Final grade of B- or higher in English 2 - Honors **OR** A- or better in English 2 - Level 1
- For 11th graders: Final grade of B- or higher in English 3 - Honors / AP English Language & Composition / AP Seminar **OR** A- or better in English 3 - Level 1

European History - Advanced Placement (AP)

Students currently enrolled in World History - AP who achieve a grade of B- or higher may continue in the Honors sequence.

Students earning a final grade of A or higher in US History 2 - Level 1 or World History - Level 1 may seek placement in American Government & Politics - AP by attaining the following criteria:

- Teacher recommendation based on demonstrated achievement/ability as evidenced by classroom performance and/or assessments
- For 10th graders: Final grade of B- or higher in English 2 - Honors **OR** A- or better in English 2 - Level 1
- For 11th graders: Final grade of B- or higher in English 3 - Honors / AP English Language & Composition / AP Seminar **OR** A- or better in English 3 - Level 1
