Drive One Providing Career Technical Education Program for Students

Our Director, James Middleditch, met and talked with Paul Tregemo, Jr., the Director at Drive One, we discussed the students that attend WAY Michigan and participate in Drive One to receive Career Technical Education in an after-school setting. WAY Michigan has fifteen students that attend virtual cohort classes in the morning and attend classes at Drive One in the afternoon to learn about several vocational skills Automotive Technology, Automotive Body, and Welding.

## **Count Day**

SPRING COUNT DAY is Wednesday, February 9. The spring count day will follow the same format as the fall count day. On February 9 your WAY Michigan researcher is required to log in and submit at least 1 step in a project in EACH of the 6 classes in their learning plan. Mentors will email researchers a list of suggested projects to work in. Researchers should also be attending each class that day as submitted steps in the class project will also count towards their Count Day submissions. If you or your researcher has any questions, please ask them to contact their mentor or team leader.

The WAY Michigan staff is officially back from our Winter Break and ready to hit the ground running! First thing on the roster is MAP Testing! This is the same testing your student(s) took in late October/early November. There was a sign up sheet, 2 tests (math and reading), and set times for students to log into zoom to take the tests. We are gearing up to do it all again. Both sets of students, middle and high schoolers, will take these tests in January. Middle School MAP testing starts Tuesday. January 18th (the day after MLK day) and runs through Friday, January 21st. High School will test starting Monday, January 31st through Friday, February 4th. This is so that we can have our test scores and report them out to CMU and our board of directors by their meeting in mid-February. The goal of the tests this time around is to show LEARNING

GROWTH - all students should score higher than they did in October/November.

Secondly, Spring Count is just over a month away, but it is never too soon to prepare! Spring Count Day is on Wednesday, February 9th! Remember that there are 3 requirements your student MUST complete within that 24-hour time frame: Log in to HERO, complete 1 submission (step, check your learning activity, or final product) in each of their 6 classes (6 submissions total), and have an academic conversation with their mentor.
