INDOOR TRACK & FIELD MEET RESULTS

Please congratulate the following Indoor Track & Field Team members for having a successful Championship season. We were fortunate to have a 4A Central Regional Championship & and top 4 athletes in each event got an opportunity to qualify and compete in the 4A STATE Championships Friday 2/18:

- We added two individual STATE Champions representing North Point: **Corinne Ball** (11) in the 55m high hurdle race and **Kevin Collins** (12) in the 55m dash.
- **Jorrell Lawton** (12) - finished 3rd place in the 55m Hurdle race
- In the 300m dash, **Kevin Collins** (12) - finished 3rd and **Valerie Nevaeh Gale** (12) finished 5th for the Girls Team in the 55m dash.
- Boys 4 X 200m Relay finished 2nd overall bringing home the silver medal. Relay participants are **Martin Spinner** (12), **Daniel Ainerua** (10), **Jeffery Robinson** (12) and **Kevin Collins** (12) anchored the relay.
- Girls 4 x 200m Relay finished in 4th place in this relay event: **Valerie Nevaeh Gale** (12), **Jordynn Akuoko** (9), **Jessica Proctor** (12) and **Corinne Ball** (11).
- Qualifying (top 4 in Regionals) and competing in the 4A STATE Meet for the first time were **Joseph Hyman** (11) & **Alaysia Jones** (10) in the Shot Put event.

In Class 4A, there were 47 schools competing in the Indoor Track & Field season. North Point's Championship TEAM consisted of 7 boys who qualified & finished as the 4th place TEAM at the State meet. North Point's Girls Team qualified 6 individual girls & finished in 9th place as a TEAM.
