WEEK 1

June 27-July 1

Community Art: In this week-long collaborative art project, our school is the canvas! This week is all about on-your-feet art projects that brighten the campus like chalk murals, fence art, yarnbombing, and light shows set to music in the Community Building.

Build Your Own Arcade Games!: Let's take a trip back in time to the old days when the internet was not a thing. Come with your imagination, creativity and desire to have fun using cardboard, glue, scissors, and other recycled materials. We are going to design and create arcade games from scratch!

WEEK 2

Good Game!: In this session, children will learn about principles of game design, play classic board games and explore their histories, invent games with found materials, and play variations of popular outdoor games.

The Magic of Science: "What would happen if..." these are the thoughts of real scientists on a daily basis. Through explorations, and trial and error, students will explore the magic of science. We will perform a variety of experiments each day using simple household materials from paper to milk.



Writers on the Block: Have you ever wanted to learn about the art of writing? Inspiration is all around....especially for the writers at Cold Spring. We are at the heart of a greater community with many stories to be told! After a week of advancing your creative writing skills, we will share our prose during a CSS Writers Showcase!

WEEK 3

July 11-15

The Art of the Broadcast: A week-long creative project, culminating in a recorded radio program including weather reports, Cold Spring news stories, interviews and a radio play, all performed by the students. In the process, students will listen to radio and use it to express creativity, think about their surroundings, and learn about their community!

Miniature World: There are so many magical and mystical things in nature that nurture creativity in all ages. Let your imagination inspire you to design and build a fantastic miniature world. We will collect natural materials and recycling items to construct our worlds from scratch. We will use a variety of small shells, acorns, pinecones, pebbles, sand, tree bark, twigs and tree cookies.

3v3 Soccer Stars: Come play 3v3 soccer with Jules, a local and regional KICK IT 3v3 champion who played in several 3v3 National Championships at Disney's Wide World of Sports. 3v3 soccer is all about quick movement of the ball, decision making under pressure, and of course, having a great time scoring lots of goals! Learn important soccer skills while playing fun and fast paced games! During this session students will be put on a team, will create their own team t-shirts and come up with a team name for the week!

WEEK 4

July 18-22

Chess: Children will spend a week learning the fundamentals of chess, playing games, and having fun with unique, multiplayer variations. They will also learn about the game's wide-ranging history, a globe-traversing journey from India to North Africa, Spain, Russia and beyond!

Character Studies: Fictional characters who feel like real people are a huge part of why we love stories! Children will reimagine their favorite book and movie characters in new settings and roles, learn how heroes and villains have different sides of the same story, and use a variety of materials to create fleshed-out characters with their own dreams, personalities, and personal flair.

Marvel:What Makes a Superhero?: Check out the ever changing Marvel Universe with Jules, self proclaimed super fan, who always sees the Marvel movies in theater! Loki opened the multiverse... so let's explore it! We will talk about the superheroes you all know and love, break down the Marvel phases, and figure out what it really means to be a superhero. From there we will see if we can create our own superhero that even the great Stan Lee would love!
