When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Am I excused from fasting and abstinence?

Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the physically or mentally ill including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also excluded are pregnant or nursing women.

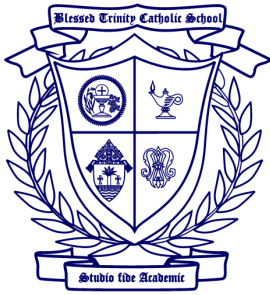

Oscar Cedeño was born at Mercy Hospital in Miami to Oscar Alberto and Martha De los Angeles and has one sister, Martha Angelica Cedeño-Diaz.

Mr. Cedeño attended and graduated from Blessed Trinity Catholic School and Immaculata-LaSalle High School. At Blessed Trinity, he served his parish as both a member of the Choir and alter server. At Immaculata-LaSalle, he played 4 years of baseball under Oscar Benitez, was a member and eventually co-president of Mindo Club (providing aid to an orphanage school in Mindo, Ecuador), and was awarded the Principal's Outstanding Senior Award by Sr. Patricia Roche, FMA.

Mr. Cedeño went on and earned his Bachelor's in History from Barry University and subsequently his Master's in Educational Leadership from St. Thomas University. Additionally, he began coaching baseball at Immaculata-LaSalle under Coach Benitez while continuing to serve in different capacities at Blessed Trinity as usher, eucharistic minister, catechist, and member of the St. Vincent de Paul Society.

Mr. Cedeño has solely worked for the Archdiocese of Miami, first teaching at Immaculata-LaSalle High School as a Social Studies teacher, Director of Student Services at Archbishop Curley-Notre Dame, and most recently Dean of Students and Asst. Principal for Student Affairs before being named Principal at Cardinal Gibbons for the 2019-2020 school year.

Mr. Cedeño had the highlight of his personal life, last June of 2021, to marry Melissa Menendez, also an educator in the Archdiocese of Miami.
