Our School Choice option is Project-Based Learning (PBL). PBL offers students the opportunity to learn content standards through real-world and personally relevant projects.



Primary Grades

Students in the upper grades built on the skills learned in the lower grades through a gardening project and learned more about our Lowcountry water habitats and environmental conservation through oyster bed replenishment. Students partnered with local experts and conducted research on field trips.

Each year students in grades 4 and 5 participate in the River of Words Project. Students learn about our Lowcountry ecosystem and show what they know through creating visual art projects and literary poetry. Each year BCSD publishes a River of Words book to celebrate student work.
