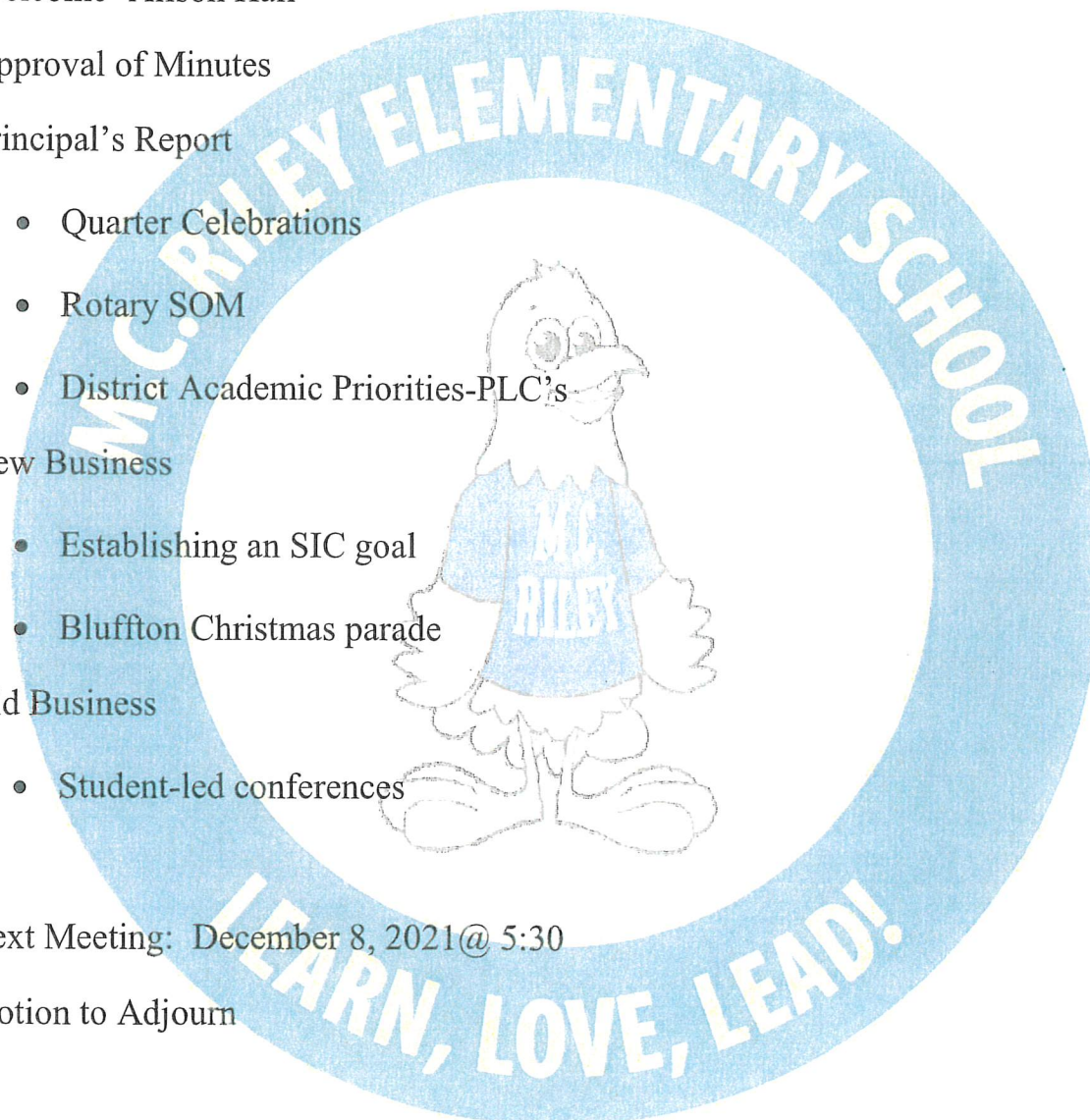

### **Principal's Report** (Samantha Ford – Assistant Principal)

- **Quarter Celebrations:** These were celebrated via Zoom in the classrooms. It was great to see the students online, working towards their WIGs. There were great presentations by teachers and students. Also was good participation by the parents.
