- **Davis HS standardized student test scores are above district and state levels. Also higher than most “comparable” schools**
- **DHS has most student growth in standardized test scores**

- **“No more, Not Here” videos in the district are moving forward**
- **Covid update: hope is that cases will decline in the next 2 weeks. 17-22% of students tested in neighboring schools tested positive during their “Test to Stay”, 14 days still used to determine positive case counts. Cases reset after 5 days off.**
