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

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

# CTE DUAL CREDIT (A.K.A. PNW COLLEGE CREDIT)

X Earn college credit for eligible CTE classes

- X Steps to Earn CTE Dual Credit:
  - X Enroll in an eligible CTE, WANIC or Satellite class
  - X Earn a B grade or above (B average for a yearlong class)
  - X Register and pay for the credit (\$50) during the same school year you take the class (June 15 deadline)
- X Financial Assistance/Fee Waivers available

# ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP)

- College level courses taught at BHS
- Demonstrates commitment & success in rigorous courses for college applications
- Most colleges offer credit or advanced college placement for AP exam scores
- Take AP exam in May (\$104 or no charge if free/reduced lunch)



# COLLEGE IN HIGH SCHOOL (CHS)

- College level course taught at BHS in partnership with a local college
- Demonstrates commitment & success in rigorous courses for college applications

Most colleges require college placement exam to get the college credit

- Earn credit in the high school class and earn college credit
- Not as easily transferred out of state as AP


# RUNNING START

- On a different school calendar (quarters vs. semesters)
- Student must be disciplined & organized, your BHS counselor will not have access to your grades and attendance




