Description

The BTEC Tech Award in Health and Social Care has been designed to give students the opportunity to develop a range of skills, techniques and attributes essential for successful performance in working life. The course is made up of three units delivered across Years 10 and 11 where students will learn about: Human Lifespan Development, Health and Social Care Services and Values, and Health and Wellbeing.

Assessment

This course is suitable for the vocational learner, who enjoys completing coursework .

Students will be assessed across the following units:

- ⇒ Health and Social Care Values (Coursework)
- ⇒ Health and Social Care Services and Values (coursework/role plays)
- ⇒ Health and Wellbeing (Examination 2 hours)

Coursework assignments may take the form of presentations, reports, booklets, displays, surveys and research. The assessment process is on-going, so it allows the student to analyse and improve their performance throughout the course. Students will be awarded Pass, Merit or Distinction according to the standard of their work.

Progression

The course is designed for those considering further study and a career in the Health and Social Care sector. You may just be interested in health or a career involved with meeting people. You may want to progress onto the BTEC Level 3 Health and Social Care programme, other Level 3 courses or A Levels.
