Maths

This week we will be looking at length and height. We will be comparing length and height using language such as longer, shorter and taller.

English

This week we will be continuing to look at our new key text 'Pattan's Pumpkin'. We will be using comparative adjectives to describe the images in the book. We will look at the suffixes used. We will begin to create a poem using our senses.

Wider Curriculum

This week we will be looking at Geography. We will be thinking about countries in the UK. We will locate England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland on a map.

Sounds Write

This week we will continue looking at the extended code.

We will begin to explore the /l/ sound and the different ways to spell the sound: l, ll, al, el, il, le and ol.

Please could you practice the following words based on our phonics this week.
Look at the spellings with the 'l' sound (l, ll, al, el, il, le and ol).

Along, pill, medal, camel, gerbil, ankle, petrol.
