Mission Statement

Sayre's Visual and Performing Arts initiative encourages students to pursue their interests in the arts – at Sayre and in our community. Students will develop artistic ability and challenge their understanding of the creative process from concept to product to presentation, and apply their interests and abilities to opportunities both in and out of the academic setting. VPA Initiative students will complete classes, projects and activities to achieve goals.

Music Performance/Music Production Requirements

- Students may apply for the initiative program sophomore year
- Complete six semesters of Sayre Singers, Spartones, Instrumental Ensemble, Piano class, Honors Music Theory, or an Independent Study, *AP Music Theory is optional*
- Participate in Sayre Recital or in the community, as a performer or production assistant at least two times during 10, 11 and 12 years
- Assist in presenting/set-up of Sayre performances and/or other productions in the community each school year
- Attend one performance outside of Sayre per semester, with faculty discussion/review to follow
- Audition/apply/participate in performances, seminars, workshops, summer programs, competitions, etc outside of Sayre, i.e. KMEA All State, CKYO or Governor's School for the Arts each school year (10, 11, 12)
- Interview a performing/production artist in the community using the provided questionnaire during senior year
- Design and complete independent project during senior year
