- Students may apply for the initiative program sophomore year
- Complete four semesters of theatre classes, including Theatre I and II
- Participate in at least four theatre productions at Sayre School
- Participate in at least two theatre productions outside of Sayre School
- Participate in at least one summer theatre event (play, camp, workshop, etc.)
- Read at least one play per semester, with faculty discussion/review to follow
- See at least one play per semester, with faculty discussion/review to follow
- Interview a working artist in the community using the provided questionnaire during senior year
- Design and complete independent project during senior year
