Dear Friends of St. Ignatius,



We have completed our 160th year in San Francisco, and we are moving on toward the next milestone. It helps to extricate oneself from the annual trek and to obtain a broader perspective on the road we have traveled until now and the journey that lies ahead of us. We seek a vantage point with a broader horizon, a clearer context and a more encompassing vision.

The photos in this issue of *Genesis* remind us of our place in San Francisco's history since 1855, and they encourage us to continue to see ourselves as part of a larger picture. We encourage our students to see themselves as situated in the context of our city, our state, our nation and our world where history is made on a daily basis. We challenge them in their classes and on their retreats to view themselves as "men and women with and for others" and as "agents of change" who can make this world a better place.

Our immediate context continues to change. We are not an institution of learning in isolation. As we moved our location across the City, we became part of different neighborhoods, and our student body grew and changed as we moved. We have grown from a school that was identified only with San Francisco to an institution that is now situated in the greater Bay Area. Our student body is more diverse than it ever was in earlier years. So the way that we build community is more challenging and demands more effort. We remind our students to be good neighbors, not only at home around the Bay, but also while they are in The Sunset District. The beautiful photos of San Francisco's location on the West Coast of the United States call us to care for our environment and our world, the one that lies beyond our immediate vision. We have so many more opportunities to engage our world, and our contemporary context must open us up to all these possibilities.

Seeing the world from above also allows us to see farther out. Just as our city, our state, our nation and our world will continue to develop, so will SI. As we approach our 50th year at our Sunset campus (in 2019), we are planning several ventures to enable our school to move into the next 50 years. We can develop this vision for the future because you have all helped us see farther, and you can help us continue to reshape and revise this vision as we move forward.

In his Spiritual Exercises, St. Ignatius presents a contemplation on the Incarnation in which he invites the retreatant to look down on the world as God views it from above. The famous photo taken by the astronaut William Anders in 1968 of "Earthrise over the Moon" invites us to enter into that vision of God, where our world is not split by borders but is something alive and whole and where differences fade into the landscape.

That is the vision we share with our students, and that is the vision we share with you in this issue of *Genesis*. On behalf of our Board of Trustees, our Board of Regents, our students, faculty and staff, thank you for your good wishes, your continued prayers and your generous financial support of our efforts to build and develop a better SI. Please be assured of the continued prayers of the entire SI community in gratitude for you and your loved ones.

After my wife and I dropped our youngest off at college recently, we had a 15-hour return trip from Spokane, Wash., to reflect on our kids' SI experience. In a generation of Facebook, texting, and all that has come with online education, we, like many parents, had to feel our way through their teenage years. We feel profoundly blessed to have been able to partner with SI's teachers, coaches and moderators in encouraging our kids to be intellectual, loving, religious, open to growth, committed to justice and called to leadership.

This partnership, like a marriage, is a relationship that takes commitment, effort, sacrifice, acceptance, forgiveness and a deep trust. One of the tangible ways that SI's parents have demonstrated their partnership is through their financial support of our mission, students, campus and programs:

- 70 percent of our parents gave to our Parent Giving Program or one of our fund-raisers.
 - Our parents donated over \$4 million — the highest total ever.
 - Our fundraisers, the fall Fashion Show and the spring Auction, both set all-time records, grossing over \$1.8 million.
 - And together with our alumni, friends and benefactors, parents gave more than \$4 million in either direct tuition assistance or to our Scholarship Endowment Fund — a tangible message that the socio-economic diversity of SI's student body is vital to our goal of forming Ignatians for and with others.
- Simply put, we could not have met the financial aid need today nor can we tomorrow without this support as the pressure mounts year after year. Did you know that in the past 10 years we have seen the following occur?
- Tuition has increased 52 percent while the amount given in financial assistance has increased 156 percent?
 - Or that the average financial assistance grant has increased from 35 percent of tuition to 54 percent?
 - Or that more than 800 students have received \$24.4 million in assistance?

Like parenting, our partnership — between you who choose to support St. Ignatius and our mission — takes trust, effort, commitment and support. And like parenting, we participate in something much bigger than ourselves. We partner in forming young men and women who have the depth, compassion and humility to see past the shallow trappings of today's world to the human condition and the great promise of the human spirit.

SI has one of the largest and most successful Advanced Placement programs in the country. In 2015, 665 students took 1,349 tests with an 80.9 percent pass rate. Also, students scored nearly 668 4s and 5s on these tests. This performance ranks SI among the top 150 schools (the top two-thirds of 1 percent) in the nation. - should receive a favorable recommendation from the principal, teacher or counselor of the school the student now attends. (Note: This recommendation will be solicited by the Admissions Office);
- should perform well enough on the entrance examination to indicate that he or she is capable of achievement in a rigorous college preparatory course of study;
- the student and parents should be committed to the student's active participation in the religious and cocurricular activities of the community he or she seeks to join. This includes a genuine interest in after-school activities, liturgies, retreats and community service.
