Item 1 **Welcome** by Mr. Hammerschmidt

Item 2 **Minutes** of the last meeting were read and approved.

Item 3 **School Safety Update** presented by Mr. Hammerschmidt

Mr. Hammerschmidt found that there was a sidewalk on the westside in the past and is hoping that after the city does their investigation, they might replace the sidewalk and signs.

He reported that we have had cones and signs to help with the safety on the west side, especially before and after school. Our assigned officer will patrol occasionally to help with the reinforcement of what we are asking parents to do in picking up their children.

When administration meets with the City, he will have the new principal be there so there will be continuity in resolving the safety issues.

Next year's Green Ribbon week should include cross walk safety with Green Ribbon Safety week along with bike safety.

Item 4 Principal Hammerschmidt reported on the **current status 2021-2022 TSSG**

Reading Goal -It is based on Growth and since it seems last year's growth was artificially high because of the Covid shut down, our current year's growth was lower than we expected and hoped.

Next year, we are discussed using BOY (beginning of year) to MOY (middle of year) benchmarks for next year growth goal and feel that would be a better measure for teachers and students to work toward within the same school year.

Math Goal - Using iReady mid year data, we are right on target for the middle of the year growth at 50%.

SEL Goal - From preliminary survey data, we are seeing improvement in our School Climate. We have met this goal and continue to work on that positive Social Emotion climate throughout the school.

Reading, Writing, Math, and Science Goal - We won't have this data until later in the year, May is the testing window.

Next year we are looking at having this 4th goal as a STEM or STEAM goal since we are already measuring reading and math progress in the other goals.

Item 5 Trustlands Budget Report

The Budget includes Team Time Tutors, Star Reading, MClass software, substitute teachers for Data Dives and Professional Development. There will be, most likely, more than 10% leftover funds. The Council voted that the extra could be spent this year on curricula materials for the academic subjects for next year. It needs to be spent by June 30th.
