Determination of NonSignificance

Description of Proposal: **Giaudrone Middle School Field and Track Conversion**

The Tacoma School District proposes to improve an existing grass athletic field and surrounding cinder-aggregate running track by replacing them with an infilled synthetic turf field and rubberized running track with the existing footprint. The project will be funded from the Capital Projects Bond, which was approved by voters in February 2020. The total anticipated disturbance is expected to be approximately 130,000 sf.


This DNS is issued under WAC 197-11-340(2) for agency consideration. The comment period will end on March 29, 2022 at 4:00pm.
