OVERVIEW

Father Ryan High School's long and celebrated history of providing quality Catholic education to the Nashville community began in 1925. As the oldest continuously operating Catholic diocesan school in Nashville, it provides an educational experience that is customized to each of their 850+ students across four learning levels, offering more than 200 academic courses. By creating an environment of personal development that encompasses the whole student spiritually, intellectually, physically, and emotionally, the faculty at Father Ryan High School empower students to live the Gospel daily in ways that strengthens capacity for moral and noble thinking and a responsibility for social justice and mercy.

By allowing students to express and develop their faith through worship, prayer and service, Father Ryan enables each student to live the Gospel daily. From Theology courses to daily prayer, to classroom discussions, the school provides young men and women an educational experience rooted in the Catholic faith.

ABOUT THE SCHOOL

Father Ryan High School's 40-acre campus includes an academic building containing computer labs, science labs, and classrooms. The administrative Cloister Building houses art rooms, band room, dining hall, and the St. James Chapel. The field house contains three full size basketball courts, a wrestling room, workout areas, locker rooms, and coaching offices. The site also has softball, baseball, soccer, lacrosse, football fields and a track. Other additions include a freestanding library, an outdoor sports and event stadium, and the Center for the Arts.

The House System

The school's newest tradition, the House System, helps guide, develop, and grow students outside of the classroom and fosters deeper relationships with teachers and lasting friendships among students of all grade levels. Launched in August 2020, the house system increases the level of mentoring and pastoral care provided to students while increasing opportunities for student leadership. At Father Ryan, there are six different houses, each with an adult Head of House and student leaders. Within each house, students are further subdivided into mentor groups that meet daily. The mentor group is the heart of the House System, for it allows community to flourish and strengthens relationships across the six levels.

Governance

As a diocesan Catholic high school, Father Ryan is subject to the canonical oversight of the Bishop of Nashville and the guidance of the Superintendent of Catholic Schools for the Diocese of Nashville. The Board of Trustees provides direction regarding the school's activities and business affairs, and is charged with exercising fiduciary responsibility for the school.

In 2007, Father Ryan High School adopted the President-Principal model of governance. The president is responsible for the advancement of the mission of the school and serves as the Chief Executive Officer with a special focus on business, development/ advancement, and capital improvements. The President is appointed by the Bishop of the Diocese of Nashville.

The responsibility and authority of this position is given by the Bishop of Nashville through the Corporate Board Members in collaboration with the Catholic Schools Office to the Board of Trustees and therefore is accountable ultimately to the Bishop for the fulfillment of their goals and policies.

FAITH LIFE

Prayer and Sacraments

Father Ryan is rooted in prayer and devoted to God in all they do. Students are invited to worship God daily, and the sacraments allow students to encounter Christ in tangible ways. All are welcome to worship and pray in the Chapel of St. James, which is at the center of the campus and the Campus Life Office. The doors are always open, the Eucharist is always present, and students are always welcome to come and encounter Christ. Students are offered seven theology courses to explore and deepen their faith.

Liturgy

All families, alumni, students, faculty, and staff are invited to Mass every morning during the week at 7:10am in the Chapel of St. James for celebration of the Eucharist. Father Ryan celebrates Mass once per month as a school, and Mass is celebrated on Holy Days of Obligation that fall on school days.

Retreats

Retreats are a treasured component of our lived mission. Annual retreats, conducted for each class separately, afford students the needed time to step away from daily routines and enter more deeply into life with Christ. In addition to personal growth, the classes experience collective growth over the four years through the bonds shared and nurtured at their annual retreats.

Father Ryan also hosts an annual retreat for mothers and daughters, providing a morning of reflection and bonding while growing in faith. Students are also encouraged to participate in other retreats through the Catholic Youth Office and their individual parishes.

Service Learning

Service learning is key to the Father Ryan experience, for it challenges students to apply the teachings of Jesus Christ beyond the textbook and classroom. Our faculty and staff have secured partnerships with 27 local service partners, and together with parents, encourage students to reach beyond themselves. Putting their Christian faith into action, our students have had a direct hand in improving the lives of our Nashville neighbors and effecting positive change in our community.

Since 2010, Father Ryan High School has hosted the Relay for Life, through the leadership and commitment of students. Inspired by the struggle of classmates who themselves battled cancer, students over the years have run this event with passion and dedication. As the largest student led Relay for Life in the country, Father Ryan raised \$175,233 in 2022. This brings the lifetime total raised by Father Ryan High School students to an impressive \$1.54M.

ACADEMICS

Accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools and Southern Association of Independent Schools, Father Ryan was the first school in the nation to receive dual accreditation from these two organizations. Academic departments generally offer courses on four levels and students are not necessarily placed in the same level in all subject areas:

- Advanced Placement (College Board courses)
- High Honors
- Honors
- College Preparatory

National Merit Honorees in 2021 The 27 College Preparatory courses offered at Father Ryan High School are rigorous programs of study which prepare the students for the demands of competitive colleges. Honors, High Honors and Advanced Placement courses are filled by qualification, application, and recommendation only. They are designed to meet the needs of students who have a high level of responsibility, who are capable of independent work, and who possess highly developed thinking skills.

Father Ryan also offers cooperative and academic support programs for students with learning differences. Students in these programs qualify for a range of support services, depending upon the learning difference and its impact on student learning.

ATHLETICS

For nearly a century, Father Ryan High School has been the epicenter of Nashville's Catholic community. With over 125 individual state championships and 65 team state championships, the school has established a major athletic presence among its competitors. An experienced and long-standing roster of accomplished coaches lead 30 interscholastic teams that compete in the TSSAA Division II. The athletic program includes football, basketball, soccer, golf, baseball, track, cross country, volleyball, golf, swimming & diving, tennis, softball, wrestling, lacrosse, ice hockey, bowling, cheerleading and rugby.

In addition, the fitness and strength program, available to all Father Ryan students, provides valuable and life-long training in fitness, nutrition, and health, and is overseen by fitness staff.

VISUAL ARTS AND THEATER

The Visual and Performing Arts Department at Father Ryan provides students with a spectrum of opportunities for pursuing their artistic and performing talents. Working with Father Ryan's award-winning faculty, students can participate in several arts activities, including an annual school play and musical, four different choirs, different dance levels, numerous bands, and studio art, 2D, and 3D design and portfolio development. Whether on the stage or in the studio, students receive exceptional training from the school's teaching artists, working professionally on their craft while teaching in the classroom, in addition to outstanding workshops presented by professional performers and touring companies. Students who participate in the arts have opportunities to perform and compete locally and internationally. There are 31 visual and performing arts course offerings to develop students' talents during their time at Father Ryan, the most of any private school in Middle Tennessee.

CLUBS AND ACTIVITIES

There are hundreds of possibilities for every student, but one aspect is the same: each receives a well-rounded education in an environment where he/she is known and loved. Father Ryan gives each student the means to learn and excel in whatever interests he or she wants to pursue. Students have more than 35 clubs and activities where they can expand their artistic skills, experience new cultures, grow in their faith, explore potential careers and so much more.

PRESIDENT: OVERVIEW OF THE POSITION

Father Ryan Catholic High School is now seeking an eligible candidate to serve as President and continue its legacy of high academic standards and spiritual development of young men and women. The Office of President has as its primary purpose to provide leadership of the school to attain the mission of Father Ryan High School. The President is the Chief Executive Officer of the school and, as such, has the general charge and control of its personnel and budget; of its educational and Advancement programs; of its business affairs; and of its facilities. He or she bears ultimate responsibility for the operation of the school that is accomplished through specific persons as agents of the President.

Working most closely with the Principal, the Board, and in varying degrees, with other groups within the school community, the President of Father Ryan High School provides leadership with regard to the purposes, values, and goals of the school.

Challenges and Opportunities

The Office of President has as its primary purpose to provide leadership in attaining the mission of Father Ryan High School. The Board of Trustees, the leadership team, faculty, and staff have set the stage for the school's next President to further advance Father Ryan's position as a premiere Catholic educational institution.

The President will continue the school's diligent efforts to build inclusivity and ensure ample demand in a highly competitive private school market. He/she will clearly define the value proposition of a high-quality Catholic high school experience, explore new pathways to expand access for those

desiring a FRHS education, and implement effective enrollment management strategies. The President will also foster positive relationships with local parishes and schools in order to fully embody the mission of a diocesan Catholic high school.

The President will work toward a sustainable model for financial stability to address long term capital needs and the recruitment, support, and retention of human resources, including a highly qualified faculty and staff who support the Father Ryan mission. He/ She will continually assess capital and master planning to achieve the mission and recognize the growing importance of engagement and philanthropy to ensure that the mission of the school remains vital and viable for future generations. The President will strive to maintain accessibility for families while continuing to offer a high-quality Catholic education experience for all.

The school will be celebrating its 100th anniversary in 2025, and the next President will have this milestone opportunity to articulate the role of Father Ryan High School and to serve as the most visible spokesperson and advocate for the school, both within the school community and in the greater Nashville area. He/ She will have the opportunity to raise the school's profile by promoting, involving, and engaging students, parents, and alumni in the fullness of the Father Ryan community.
