Monday, March 14th Masks Are Optional In Most School Settings

Starting Monday, March 14th, the wearing of masks at school is optional. We are asking all families to please have a discussion with your student if you wish for them to continue to mask at school.

Also, if your student visits the health room, they will be required to wear a mask. We will be providing disposable masks for students to wear during their visit.

Chromebooks

Several families have asked lately, do we need to continue having our student bring their Chromebook back and forth to school daily. We are asking all families to send to school your student's Chromebook and charger. We will be keeping them at school.

Classroom teachers will only send the Chromebook home if you request your student bring it home via Seesaw to work on our school platforms, Lexia Core 5, Dreambox, Reflex, or Seesaw activities. If your student should become ill along with a packet being prepared their Chromebook will be sent home so they can work on school platforms too. Teachers will also notify you via Seesaw if your student is working on a class project and will be bringing their Chromebook home.

OSAS Testing for Students Gr. 3-5

The OSAS (Oregon Statewide Assessment System) test is one of many assessment tools used to measure academic progress. Our school will be testing students in grades 3—5 in the areas of math and reading. 5th grade students are also required to take a science test. These assessments meet the requirements of the Every Student Succeed Act, a piece of federal legislation. You may view a sample test questions at:

The results of the OSAS assessments enable both the district, our school and teachers an opportunity to celebrate successes and focus on areas in which growth is needed. Our staff will reassure your child that while this test is important, it is not something in which they should become overly stressed about. We find encouraging students to do their best, building their confidence and supporting their efforts is beneficial.

Oregon law (ORS 329.479) permits parents and adult students to annually opt-out of Oregon's statewide summative tests in English Language Arts and Math by submitting a form available at

<https://phes.pleasanthill.k12.or.us/resources/parent-resources>, to the school the student attends.

Schools will provide parents with the 2022-23 form at least 30 days prior to the start of testing.

Classroom teachers will notify families when they are going to begin testing.
