Position Purpose

Assists the Lead Counselor and Activity Instructors in supervising campers entering PK-8th Grades enrolled in Summerside Camps and ensures all campers have fun in a safe environment. Facilitates activities by establishing a relationship with the Day Camp Director and campers utilizing learning resources and the SCH environment. Develops and fosters the appropriate skills and social abilities to enable the optimum development of children, according to age, ability, and aptitude.

Essential Functions

- At the direction of the Instructor/Lead Counselor of their assigned group, help implement activities with campers.
- Prepares materials for activities and assists with the cleanup
- Supports rules of conduct and creates a warm and welcoming environment,
- Employ appropriate group and behavior management techniques with campers.
- Maintains order in the classroom and throughout common areas of the campus, including the playground.
- Attends work and arrives/departs work at the appropriate times as determined by the immediate supervisor.
- Assumes other job-related duties assigned by the immediate supervisor.

• Strong interpersonal and communication skills and the ability to work effectively with a wide range of constituencies in a diverse community.

- Willingness to be flexible with change in duties.
- Knowledge of content, methods, materials, and equipment for Summer Programs.

- Ability to provide a supportive and caring environment for children.
- Ability to assist with reinforcing positive camper behavior and group management
- Comfortable with a team-based work structure; ability to demonstrate flexibility on the job.
- Demonstrates initiative, is conscientious, and provides complete follow-through on areas of responsibility.
- Must be 15 years of age or older.
- At least one year of experience working with children ages 3-10 years
